



Nature Photography Adventures: Botswana with Diane Kelsay and Bob Harvey

Makgadikgadi Pans Extension

August 30-September 2 2013

August 30, 31 & September 1: Makgadikgadi Pans National Park, Kalahari

Enjoy a morning activity before departing on our scheduled charter flight over the Okavango Delta to the desert location of our final camp. Leroo La Tau Camp is situated on the banks of the Boteti River which forms the western boundary of Makgadikgadi Pans National Park. The camp rises majestically above the dry Boteti Riverbed which stretches across the western border of the Makgadikgadi Pans National Park. Here we'll take day and night game drives with the possibility of boating on the Boteti River, depending on the water levels.

The park, populated by up to 30,000 zebra and wildebeest closely accompanied by predators, offers us the chance to experience the exhilaration of photographing large concentrations of game and the resultant predator interaction. The lodge offers a raised hide above the Boteti River where guests can enjoy spectacular wildlife sightings. Having explored the area and enjoyed a spectacular wildlife phenomenon on guided day and night game drives, we can retire after dinner to a splendid fireplace overlooking the waterhole. Leroo La Tau translates as 'lion's paw', but although the surrounding area features abundant lion, zebra and wildebeest, it also boasts Chobe bushbuck, leopard, cheetah, brown- and spotted-hyena, impala, kudu, jackal, porcupine, genet and caracal, to name but a few. In addition, there is also the possibility of seeing the rare white rhinoceros. Overnights Leroo La Tau Camp. All meals.

Leroo La Tau

Leroo La Tau is situated on the western bank of the Boteti River; the river's eastern bank forms the boundary of the Makgadikgadi Pans National Park. The lodge features 12 luxurious thatched and glass fronted suites with en suite bathrooms, each one raised on a wooden platform. The main lounge and dining area, with its inviting wooden and thatch finish, offers guests the opportunity to sit back and relax at the bar while listening to the wide variety of night sounds so characteristic of the African bush. Alternatively you can lounge around the swimming pool or enjoy the panoramic river vista from the game viewing hide built into the bank of the river.



September 2: Depart

Spent our last morning in Botswana picking up a few more shots before our light air charter flight to Maun Airport to meet our departing flights. Breakfast.
